## **Rocky Mountain House practice requires a Registered Midwife to start June 2017.**

Blessing Way Midwifery is a well established rural practice located in Rocky Mountain House, Alberta. We are looking for a midwife who is interested in providing care to a diverse population with two other Registered Midwives.

At Blessing Way we provide prenatal care to a wonderfully diverse clientele at our own clinic space located in the town of Rocky Mountain House in a heritage house. Midwives offer both home and hospital birth. Additionally, we are part of an alternative funding program that provides care to three First Nations communities in our area through the Rocky Primary Care Network. Once a week, a midwife travels to one of the Health Centers, located in a First Nations community, providing prenatal care. The women are offered continuity of care and birth with the midwife at the Rocky Hospital.

We have a strong working relationship with the hospital and the physicians in our community. Admitting privileges in one rural and one urban hospital in the area are part of our working arrangements. We do have privileges to do water births in the hospitals we work with, both hospital provide water birth tubs.

The interested applicants should:

- Be eligible for registration with the College of Midwives of Alberta and have current CPR, NRP, and Emergency Skills certification.
- Ideally, have at least one year of midwifery experience including out-of-hospital births. However consideration will be given to New Graduates/ New Registrants with an interest in practicing in a rural environment and/ or interest in establishing a new practice in a RURAL area once their New Registrant's year is completed.
- Have excellent communication skills, work well within a small team, and contribute positively to the practice and the community.
- Be flexible and reliable with on-call rotation
- Hold a full driver's license and have access to a vehicle.
- Have an interest in serving indigenous populations
- Be willing to preceptor students
